- Lady Jane Grey



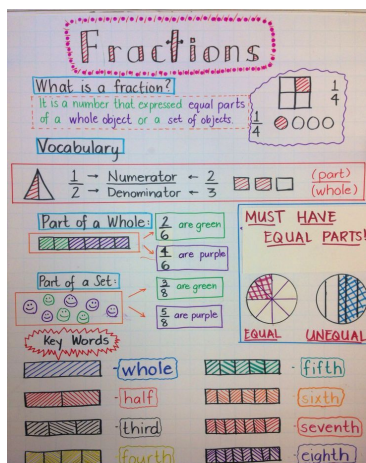
