Bubbles and consistent groupings







Consistent groups reduce the risk of transmission by reducing the number of children and staff in contact with each other.

Where possible children will be kept to year group bubbles but there will be sharing of facilities and staff across phases. Drop off and collection

Entry to the School Office

- Entry into the school building must be limited and by appointment or approval from a senior leader in advance.
- We will stay as welcoming as we possibly can. Staff will be on duty to help you in the mornings.
- Email and phone class are going to be the best way to contact us.
- Ensure you keep an eye on the twitter account as well for other information and news.



Face Coverings

- Parents and carers are advised to wear face coverings when onsite when dropping off and collecting their children.
- Children do not need to wear face coverings.
- Some staff will wear masks and or visors in communal areas inside the school. Visitors to the site will wear them too. Masks will not be worn by staff in classrooms



Medication



Wherever possible medication should be administered at home by parents before arriving at school. Please email us exact details of what you require and we will liaise with parents accordingly.

Infection control measures



Don't come to school if anyone in your household has symptoms of coronavirus.





Stay at home and get a test.



If your child is unwell during the school day, you will need to collect them without delay.

School Procedures to keep everyone safe

To keep everyone safe we as a school community will do the following:

- Regular handwashing and the use of sanitizer
- Increased cleaning regimes
- Staff maintaining social distance as much as possible without impacting on learning
- No large gatherings or assemblies
- No singing, chanting or shouting
- Items from home quarantined for 48 hours
- Only essential visitors parents admitted for emergencies only or pre booked appointment via phone or emailing the office
- Normal lesson experience for children as much as possible

Equipment and Uniform


It is important that children only bring the necessary things to school and that all items are **named**.

We will not be running after school clubs to reduce external adults on site and the chance of cross bubble mixing

Lunches



Infant children are entitled to a school provided meal - children in Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 will have a school provided meal and not bring in home pack lunches

Junior school children can have a school provided meal or home pack lunch

There will be different sittings to keep the year groups and bubbles apart in the dining hall and conservatory

Outdoor spaces have been split and bubbles will not share toys or resources
