<p>Research the life of a President of the USA. Create a presentation about their life.</p> <p>2 merits</p>	<p>Create a travel brochure for a holiday to North or South America.</p> <p>4 merits</p>	<p>Research a state in North America. Present this as a report.</p> <p>3 merits</p>
<p>Make a poster explaining how to care for your teeth properly.</p> <p>3 merits</p>	<p>Create and illustrate a food chain starting with a predator of your choice.</p> <p>2 merits</p>	<p>Make an instrument out of junk and perform a song at home.</p> <p>3 merits</p>
<p>Make and label a family tree in Spanish for your own family or an imaginary family.</p> <p>3 merits</p>	<p>Make a paper clock and practice using it to tell the time. You could use Roman numerals for the numbers.</p> <p>2 merits</p>	<p>Do something to help your local environment and document what you do.</p> <p>3 merits</p>
